Escarpment Views took part in Open Streets Hamilton on June 12, giving free rides on a tandem bicycle as well as free back issues.

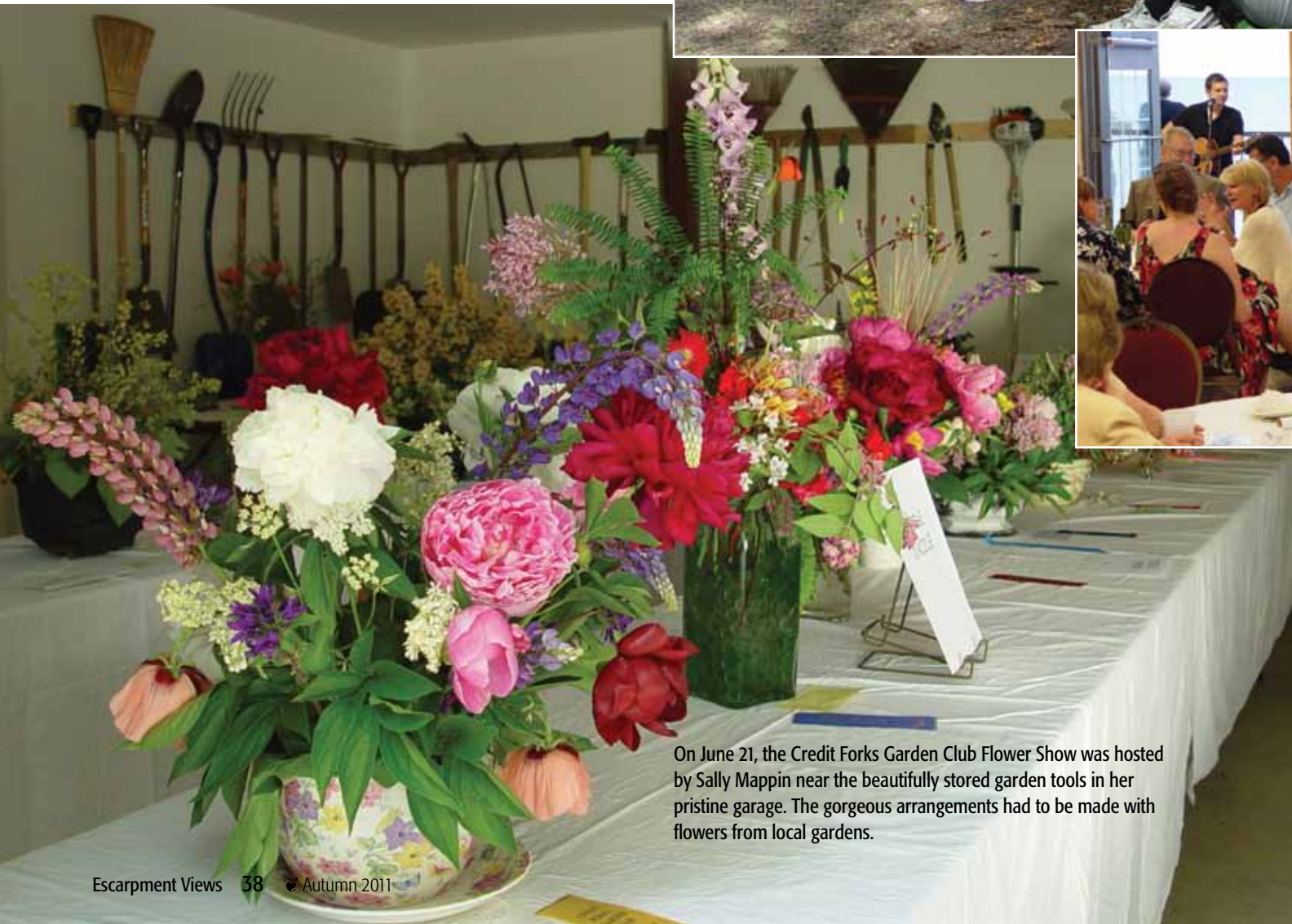
